### **Worship Facilitator**

#### ***Title***

Worship Facilitator

#### ***Purpose***

The Worship Facilitator plays an important role in leading the congregation in expressing the love and adoration of God through Worship. The Worship Facilitator equips the congregation for worship through music and liturgical arts. The Worship Facilitator works with the pastor, session and the education and worship committees to plan and implement all aspects of CSPC's worship.

#### ***Responsible to***

The Personnel Committee with direction from the Pastor.

#### ***Description of duties***

- Work with Pastor to plan and execute dynamic worship services including Sunday Experiential service, Classic Worship and special services.
- Assist Pastor in the selection of music and liturgy (including liturgical arts of all forms)
- Recruit musicians, including ensembles, choirs, and praise band (vocalist and instrumentalists). Schedule rehearsals and work with musicians to bring forth the best offerings of their talents using guitar, piano, hand bells, organ and voice. This requires the worship leader have capabilities in voice, piano and guitar. It also requires knowledge of all musical styles from traditional to contemporary.
- Recruit and work with other liturgical artists to execute enhancements to worship as decided upon by session and Pastor. May include, but not limited to; creative liturgy, liturgical dance, drama, and new media.
- Oversee maintenance of all CSPC musical instruments and liturgical paraments.
- Oversee operation and maintenance of media systems including recruiting and training of volunteers

- Create budget and purchase choral music, instruments, equipment, instrumental music, music and media licenses, hymnals, and other worship-related needs.
- Act as a resource for other musical needs such as VBS and Sunday School that come through session.
- Will attend appropriate Committee meetings when requested.
- Will lead others in worship by singing.
- Will lead the worship musically with an instrument (i.e. guitar and/or piano)

### ***Time requirements***

8-12 hours per week with a target of 10 (5 hours on Sunday morning, 5 hours in preparation, extra 2 hours for special mid week services as church season directs.)

### ***Minimal Position Requirements***

An enthusiastic Christian musician having completed two years of college and having a willingness to understand and support reformed worship.

### ***Skills and Gifts***

- A commitment to Christ.
- Musical and Liturgical knowledge and training.
- Love of music (traditional hymns, contemporary, classical, choral and praise music)
- Creative skills.
- Good organizational and communication skills.
- Good interpersonal skills—able to get along with many different personality types.
- Leadership skills: motivational, recruiting, shepherding.
- Detail-oriented.
- Dependable

### ***Optimal Candidate***

The optimal candidate will be an accomplished musician (guitar and piano) with experience facilitating group musical worship experiences. The candidate will possess or be pursuing a degree in music or theology (including Christian Education). The candidate should have a strong desire to work with the pastor and session in development of dynamic, meaningful worship with an understanding of the reformed tradition.

### ***Compensation***

Compensation is negotiable and commensurate with the candidate's experience.
