 - Bring shower shoes
- We will use the large kitchen in the church.
 - There is a dishwasher
 - Bring your own coffee cup and save on throw a-ways
- Meals are in the fellowship hall
 - Bring your own water bottle to save on the plastic throw a-ways
- The Church also has an air conditioned gymnasium and another large room that will accommodate groups and a place to rest and relax
 - We have cable TV and wireless internet
