LEARNED about the Near East School of Theology in Beirut, Lebanon from its development director and PC(USA) mission co-worker Carol Dolezal-Ng.

PRESENTED a \$6,000 grant from the Presbyterian Hunger Program to the Cincinnati Contact Center for its Empowerment Project.

LEARNED about different ways that Outdoor Ministry and Christian Education scholarships were used during the last year, including a Vacation Bible School conducted by Third and Ft. Thomas First churches and an event for adolescent girls held by Bethel Murdoch, Grace Community and Loveland churches.

HEARD a recap of Ben Darby's service as a Young Adult Volunteer and plans for Rachel Hosmer (Northminster) to serve as a YAV in Denver.

HEARD about the Christian Community Development Association conference to be held in Cincinnati, October 21-25.

DISMISSED commissions that installed Bobbie Bella (pastor, Pleasant Run), Cheryl Edmonds (pastor, Grace Community), Edward Goode (pastor, Wyoming), Shirley Hutchins (associate pastor, Sycamore).
