Announcing a New Presbytery Initiative: UKirk at the University of Cincinnati

Want to be part of a dynamic new Presbytery initiative to solidify UC college students' faith? The Presbytery is starting a UKirk Collegiate Ministry at the University of Cincinnati, with ministry activities hopefully beginning with the start of the 2019-20 academic year! Would someone in your congregation love to be a part of the Board that governs the program?

UKirk will operate under the direction of a Board of Directors, who will be appointed by and accountable to Presbytery Council, made up of interested parties from throughout the Presbytery, and will help design and coordinate an active Presbyterian campus ministry on the UC Clifton campus, focused on ministering among UC undergraduate and graduate students. The Board will be constructed of two classes, each serving two-year terms (Class of 2021 and 2022). UKirk will operate primarily through Immanuel Presbyterian Church as the "host church" due to proximity to campus.
